Well, it happened *just before* DebCamp, but...

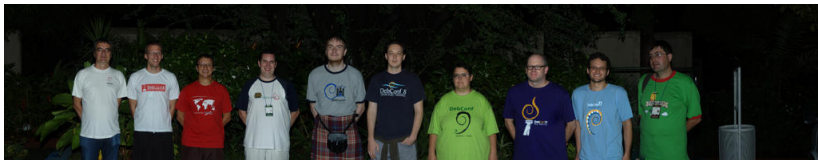
Cheers anyway!
